Where will they be?

- Domestic
 - Your flight's designated carousel for baggage claim
- International
 - End of the exit aisle, under the two large wooden figures in the international arrival hall







DOMESTIC ARRIVALS



- Look for staff at your flight's designated baggage carousel
- 2. Once you've met our staff, collect your checked bag(s) from the carousel
- 3. Listen to the directions from our staff and they will guide you to the holding area for check-in
- 4. Once student have checked-in at our holding area, they will be seated nearby the holding area and wait for the next airport shuttle



FAQ (Domestic only)

RESIDENCE STUDENTS ONLY

When will staff be at the carousel of my flight?

- Always look for Pre-University staff before looking for your bag(s)
- Staff will be there until the carousel stops spinning for your flight

If I can't locate any Pre-University staff...

- Our staff will be stationed at our holding zone in the Domestic Arrival level
- Holding zone is located near Carousel #3, right in front of Paper Planes Café.

INTERNATIONAL ARRIVALS

RESIDENCE STUDENTS ONLY

- 1. After collecting your checked bag(s), walk towards the exit with the flow
- 2. Once you have walked till the end of the exit aisle, you will see two tall wooden figures in front of you
- 3. Staff will be waiting in front of the two wooden figures with their t-shirt and signage
- 4. Approach them and introduce yourself, follow their instructions, and they will walk you to the holding area for check-in


