Course Outline

Course Objectives

In this course you will learn the structure and vocabulary to function in everyday situations such as exchanging basic information about yourself and your family, shopping, ordering food in a restaurant, and describing daily activities.

Course Content

- Greetings and daily expressions
- Introducing oneself: name, occupation, hobby, nationality etc.
- Telling names of things and ownership
- Telling time, days and months
- Shopping, ordering food in a restaurant
- Describing daily activities and asking questions: Non-past and past tense, interrogative questions
- Talking about family members: How many people, who they are, what they do, what they like etc.
- Expressing likes and dislikes: food, sports, music etc.
- Hiragana: Learn to read and write the Japanese phonetic characters, Hiragana
