Prerequisite: Japanese Beginner I or equivalent.

Course Objectives

- Build vocabulary and fluency in everyday situations
- Learning the verb forms and sentence patterns for different situations such as:
 - inviting someone for something
 - requesting something
 - asking for permission.

Course Content

- Adjectives
- Inviting and suggesting: Let's do ... Would you like to ...
- Expressing desire: I want to do such and such
- Talking about your health: Parts of the body, health related words
- Comparisons: Which do you like better, A or B?
- Verb conjugations: Learning verb forms
- Action in progress: Someone is doing such and such
- Verb "to wear": Describing what the person is wearing
- Making requests: Please do such and such
- Asking for permission: May I do such and such
- Refusal: Please don't do such and such
- Describing locations and Giving directions: There is something ..., Something is at ..., Go straight, turn right, and such and such is on your left
- Katakana: Learn to read and write the Japanese Katakana characters used for words of foreign origin
